**Resolution of the Harrison County Commissioners Court
Concerning the Regular Term of Court Fiscal Year 2025-2026**

WHEREAS, Local Government Code §81.005 states that "at the last regular term of each fiscal year of the county, the commissioners court by order shall designate a day of the week on which the court shall convene in a regular term each month during the next fiscal year. If the completion of the court's business does not require a monthly term, the court need not hold more than one term a quarter. A regular term may continue for one week but may be adjourned earlier if the court's business is completed"; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the regular term of the Harrison County Commissioners Court for fiscal year 2025-2026 shall be convened every other Thursday; in the event of any scheduling conflicts, such as holidays, the Commissioners Court will, at a regular term meeting prior to the conflict, set an appropriate substitute day to meet at the Court's convenience. The senior member of the Commissioner's Court shall serve as Judge Pro Tem for said meetings in the absence of the County Judge.
