**GENERAL PURPOSE:** Operates assigned equipment and participates in the maintenance and repair of County roads.

## PRIMARY DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

The following duties **ARE NOT** intended to serve as a comprehensive list of all duties performed by all employees in this classification, only a representative summary of the primary duties and responsibilities. Incumbent(s) may not be required to perform all duties listed and may be required to perform additional, position-specific duties.

- Assists in ensuring County roadways are safely and properly maintained for use by the public.
- Drives dump trucks and transports dirt, gravel, asphalt, and/or other types of material to job sites.
- Operates various types of equipment used in road maintenance including but not limited to front end loaders, zippers, mixers, chippers, and rollers.
- Patches roads; prepares road base and/or mixes materials used in the construction of roadways.
- Participates in lifting and moving concrete bags.
- Performs general road maintenance duties including trimming trees around roadways.
- Responds to road maintenance emergencies and provides on-call assistance as required.
- Maintains compliance with regulations and safety standards governing road maintenance work.
- Performs other duties as assigned or required.
